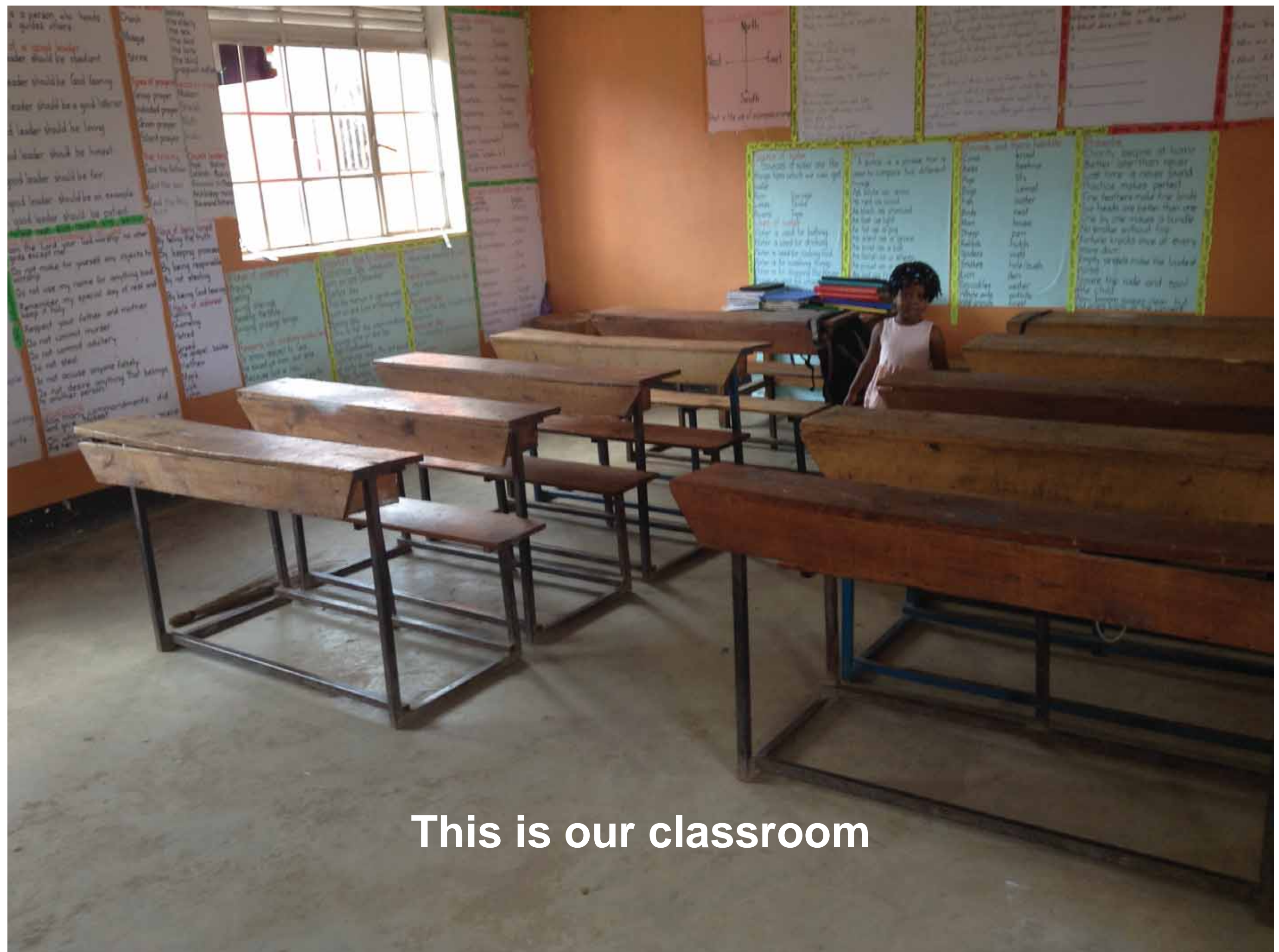
**This is the primary school and dormitories**

**This is our new cooker**





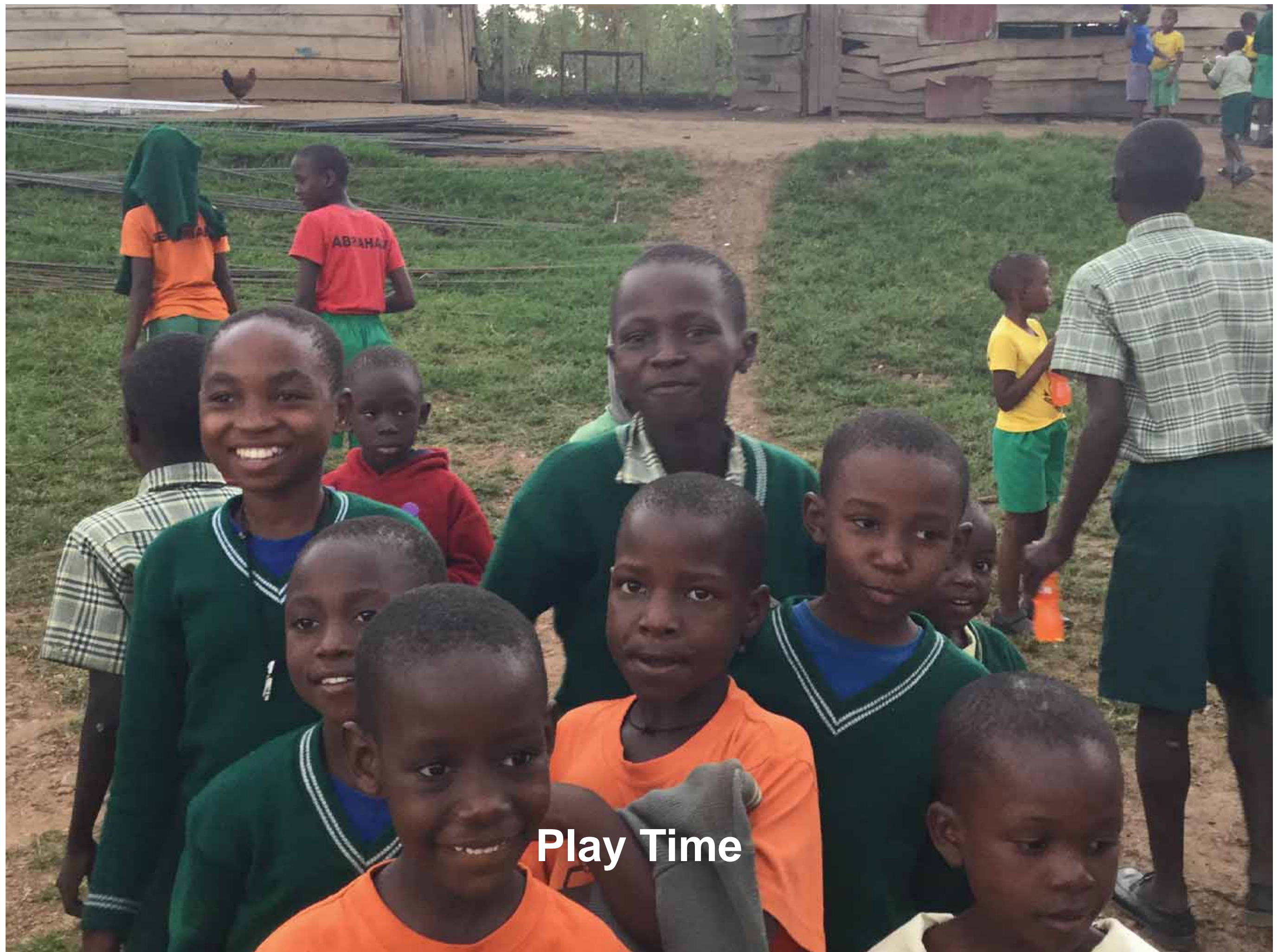
**ARGH DINNER!!**
